

Daisy Bonnet

Materials: appx 60-120yd dk weight yarn (I used knitpicks capra) and 20 or so yds of lace weight mohair (I used rowan kidsilk haze), size 6 (4mm) straight needles or size needed to obtain gauge), 4mm crochet hook for the crochet edge

Gauge: appx 5sts/inch Gauge is very important!

Sizes (appx finished head circumference): newborn (13ins), 0-3mths (14 ins), 3-6mths (15ins), 6-12mths (16ins), 1-3yrs (17ins)

Stitch Key

K - knit p - purl w - wrap sl - slip K2tog - knit 2 stitches together p2tog - purl 2 stitches together Yo- yarn over sc - single crochet dc - double crochet

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NEWBORN

Cast on 55 stitches in your dk weight yarn.

Work 3/4in of stockinette stitch ending after completing a wrong side (purl) row. Cut yarn (leaving enough to weave in ends) and pick up mohair yarn.

LACE PANEL

Row 1 - knit across

Row 2 - k1 [k5 wrapping your yarn 3times with each k (picture tutorial at the end), k1] repeat [to] across

Row 3 - p1 [yarn back, sl purlwise into the first wrap of each of the next 5 sts, wrap your yarn around these 5 stitches twice back to front (picture tutorial at the end of pattern), p1] repeat [to] across

Row - 4 knit across

Cut yarn (leaving enough to weave in ends) and pick up dk yarn.

Work in stockinette st beginning with a right side row (knit row) until your work measures 4ins from cast on edge. End after completing a wrong side (purl) row. Place a marker on either side of your work here.

DECREASES

Row 1 - k1 [k2tog, k4] repeat [to] across (46st)

Row 2 - purl across

Row 3 - k1 [k2tog, k3] repeat [to] across (37st)

Row 4 - purl across

Row 5 - k1 [k2tog, k2] repeat [to] across (28st)

Row 6 - purl across

Row 7 - k1 [k2tog, k1] repeat [to] across (19st)

Row 8 - purl across

Row 9 - k1 [k2tog] repeat [to] across (10st)

Do not bind off. Cut yarn leaving appx -10ins. Pull yarn through remaining stitches and cinch the back tight. Using this end sew the crown together to your stitch markers. (I like to use the mattress stitch since it is nearly invisible).

EDGE

With your crochet hook and mohair yarn join yarn in first stitch on your cast on edge. Sc, [skip 2 sts 5dc into next st, skip 2 sts, sc] repeat [to] across cast on edge.

0-3 MONTHS

Cast on 61 stitches in your dk weight yarn.

Work 3/4in of stockinette stitch ending after completing a wrong side (purl) row. Cut yarn (leaving enough to weave in ends) and pick up mohair yarn.

LACE PANEL

Row 1 - knit across

Row 2 - k1 [k5 wrapping your yarn 3times with each k (picture tutorial at the end), k1] repeat [to] across

Row 3 - p1 [yarn back, sl purlwise into the first wrap of each of the next 5 sts, wrap your yarn around these 5 stitches twice back to front (picture tutorial at the end of pattern), p1] repeat [to] across

Row - 4 knit across

Cut yarn (leaving enough to weave in ends) and pick up dk yarn.

Work in stockinette st beginning with a right side row (knit row) until your work measures 4.5ins from cast on edge. End after completing a wrong side (purl) row. Place a marker on either side of your work here.

DECREASES

Row 1 - k1 [k2tog, k4] repeat [to] across (51st)

Row 2 - purl across

Row 3 - k1 [k2tog, k3] repeat [to] across (41st)

Row 4 - purl across

Row 5 - k1 [k2tog, k2] repeat [to] across (31st)

Row 6 - purl across

Row 7 - k1 [k2tog, k1] repeat [to] across (21st)

Row 8 - purl across

Row 9 - k1 [k2tog] repeat [to] across (11st)

Do not bind off. Cut yarn leaving appx -10ins. Pull yarn through remaining stitches and cinch the back tight. Using this end sew the crown together to your stitch markers. (I like to use the mattress stitch since it is nearly invisible).

EDGE

With your crochet hook and mohair yarn join yarn in first stitch on your cast on edge. Sc, [skip 2 sts 5dc into next st, skip 2 sts, sc] repeat [to] across cast on edge.

3-6 MONTHS

Cast on 67 stitches in your dk weight yarn.

Work 1in of stockinette stich ending after completing a wrong side (purl) row.

Cut yarn (leaving enough to weave in ends) and pick up mohair yarn.

LACE PANEL

Row 1 - knit across

Row 2 - k1 [k5 wrapping your yarn 3times with each k (picture tutorial at the end), k1] repeat [to] across

Row 3 - p1 [yarn back, sl purlwise into the first wrap of each of the next 5 sts, wrap your yarn around these 5 stitches twice back to front (picture tutorial at the end of pattern), p1] repeat [to] across

Row - 4 knit across

Cut yarn (leaving enough to weave in ends) and pick up dk yarn.

Work in stockinette st beginning with a right side row (knit row) until your work measures 5ins from cast on edge. End after completing a wrong side (purl) row. Place a marker on either side of your work here.

DECREASES

Row 1 - k1 [k2tog, k4] repeat [to] across (56st)

Row 2 - purl across

Row 3 - k1 [k2tog, k3] repeat [to] across (45st)

Row 4 - purl across

Row 5 - k1 [k2tog, k2] repeat [to] across (34st)

Row 6 - purl across

Row 7 - k1 [k2tog, k1] repeat [to] across (23st)

Row 8 - purl across

Row 9 - k1 [k2tog] repeat [to] across (12st)

Do not bind off. Cut yarn leaving appx -10ins. Pull yarn through remaining stitches and cinch the back tight. Using this end sew the crown together to your stitch markers. (I like to use the mattress stitch since it is nearly invisible).

EDGE

With your crochet hook and mohair yarn join yarn in first stitch on your cast on edge. Sc, [skip 2 sts 5dc into next st, skip 2 sts, sc] repeat [to] across cast on edge.

6-12 MONTHS

Cast on 73 stitches in your dk weight yarn.

Work 1in of stockinette stich ending after completing a wrong side (purl) row.

Cut yarn (leaving enough to weave in ends) and pick up mohair yarn.

LACE PANEL

Row 1 - knit across

Row 2 - k1 [k5 wrapping your yarn 3times with each k (picture tutorial at the end), k1] repeat [to] across

Row 3 - p1 [yarn back, sl purlwise into the first wrap of each of the next 5 sts, wrap your yarn around these 5 stitches twice back to front (picture tutorial at the end of pattern), p1] repeat [to] across

Row - 4 knit across

Cut yarn (leaving enough to weave in ends) and pick up dk yarn.

Work in stockinette st beginning with a right side row (knit row) until your work measures 5.5ins from cast on edge. End after completing a right side (knit) row. Place a marker on either side of your work here.

DECREASES

Row 1 - p70sts, p2tog, p1 (72sts)

Row 2 - k1 [k2tog, k5] repeat [to] across to last st, k1 (62st)

Row 3 - purl across

Row 4 - k1 [k2tog, k4] repeat [to] across to last st, k1 (52st)

Row 5 - purl across

Row 6 - k1 [k2tog, k3] repeat [to] across to last st, k1 (42st)

Row 7 - purl across

Row 8 - k1 [k2tog, k2] repeat [to] across to last st, k1 (32st)

Row 9 - purl across

Row 10 - k1 [k2tog, k1] repeat [to] across to last st, k1 (22st)

Row 11 - purl across

Row 12 - k1 [k2tog] repeat [to] across to last st, k1 (12st)

Do not bind off. Cut yarn leaving appx -10ins. Pull yarn through remaining stitches and cinch the back tight. Using this end sew the crown together to your stitch markers. (I like to use the mattress stitch since it is nearly invisible).

EDGE

With your crochet hook and mohair yarn join yarn in first stitch on your cast on edge. Sc, [skip 2 sts 5dc into next st, skip 2 sts, sc] repeat [to] across cast on edge.

TODDLER (1-3YRS)

Cast on 79 stitches in your dk weight yarn.

Work 1.25ins of stockinette stich ending after completing a wrong side (purl) row. Cut yarn (leaving enough to weave in ends) and pick up mohair yarn.

LACE PANEL

Row 1 - knit across

Row 2 - k1 [k5 wrapping your yarn 3times with each k (picture tutorial at the end), k1] repeat [to] across

Row 3 - p1 [yarn back, sl purlwise into the first wrap of each of the next 5 sts, wrap your yarn around these 5 stitches twice back to front (picture tutorial at the end of pattern), p1] repeat [to] across

Row - 4 knit across

Cut yarn (leaving enough to weave in ends) and pick up dk yarn.

Work in stockinette st beginning with a right side row (knit row) until your work measures 6ins from cast on edge. End after completing a wrong side (purl) row. Place a marker on either side of your work here.

DECREASES

Row 1 - k1 [k2tog, k5] repeat [to] across to last st, k1 (68st)

Row 2 - purl across

Row 3 - k1 [k2tog, k4] repeat [to] across to last st, k1 (57st)

Row 4 - purl across

Row 5 - k1 [k2tog, k3] repeat [to] across to last st, k1 (46st)

Row 6 - purl across

Row 7 - k1 [k2tog, k2] repeat [to] across to last st, k1 (35st)

Row 8 - purl across

Row 9 - k1 [k2tog, k1] repeat [to] across to last st, k1 (24st)

Row 10 - purl across

Row 11 - k1 [k2tog] repeat [to] across to last st, k1 (13st)


Do not bind off. Cut yarn leaving appx -10ins. Pull yarn through remaining stitches and cinch the back tight. Using this end sew the crown together to your stitch markers. (I like to use the mattress stitch since it is nearly invisible).

EDGE


With your crochet hook and mohair yarn join yarn in first stitch on your cast on edge. Sc, [skip 2 sts 5dc into next st, skip 2 sts, sc] repeat [to] across cast on edge.

ROW 2 TUTORIAL

LEFT HANDED




RIGHT HANDED




Insert your needle into the next stitch knit wise, wrap your yarn around your working needle 3 times, pull through your stitch.

ROW 3 TUTORIAL LEFT HANDED



RIGHT HANDED



Place your yarn to the back. Slip the first wrap only from the 5 3wrapped stitches from row 2 purlwise (making a long stitch). Now wrap your yarn around the post of those long stitches twice, back to front. You will need to move your stitches from

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5 long stitched on a safety	needle as you do this. Or you could cheat and place these pin, stitch marker or cable needle and wrap around them. Bring your yarn to the front to purl your next stitch.
