<p>Yarn – Hobbii Rainbow Bamboo (100g 274yd) or 1200 (1400, 1600) yds of your favorite sport weight (size 3) yarn</p>	<p>Bethany Blanket is a classic styled baby blanket in 3 sizes for all your vintage inspired needs.</p>
<p>Gauge - 26x36sts per 4x4in or 10x10cm</p>	<p>It is named after our micro preemie warrior of a daughter and made to match the Bethany Pixie Bonnet.</p>
<p>Needles - 4 (3.5mm) circular needles (I used a 24in length)</p>	<p>Abbreviations can be found on the last page.</p>
<p>Sizes – car seat (crib, toddler)</p>	
<p>Finished Measurement – 22-28ins/55-70cm (28-36in/70x90cm, 36-48in/90x120cm)</p>	
<p>Other –yarn needle</p>	

### Car Seat

Cast on 158sts. I used the long tail cast on.

Work in garter stitch (knit every row) for 12 rows.

Row 1 (rs) - k6, (p3, yo, k1, p3, k4, k2tog) repeat (to) across to last 9sts, p3, k6  
Row 2 (ws) - k9, (p5, k3, p2, k3) repeat (to) across to last 6sts, k6  
Row 3 - k6, (p3, k1, yo, k1, p3, k3, k2tog) repeat (to) across to last 9sts, p3, k6  
Row 4 - k9, (p4, k3, p3, k3) repeat (to) across 6sts, k6  
Row 5 - k6, (p3, k2, yo, k1, p3, k2, k2tog) repeat (to) across to last 9sts, p3, k6  
Row 6 - k9, (p3, k3, p4, k3) repeat (to) across 6sts, k6  
Row 7 - k6, (p3, k3, yo, k1, p3, k1, k2tog) repeat (to) across to last 9sts, p3, k6  
Row 8 - k9, (p2, k3, p5, k3) repeat (to) across 6sts, k6  
Row 9 - k6, (p3, k4, yo, k1, p3, k2tog) repeat (to) across to last 9sts, p3, k6  
Row 10 - k9, (p1, k3, p6, k3) repeat (to) across 6sts, k6  
Row 11 - k6, (p3, ssk, k4, p3, k1, yo) repeat (to) across to last 9sts, p3, k6  
Row 12 - k9, (p2, k3, p5, k3) repeat (to) across 6sts, k6  
Row 13 - k6, (p3, ssk, k3, p3, k1, yo, k1) repeat (to) across to last 9sts, p3, k6  
Row 14 - k9, (p3, k3, p4, k3) repeat (to) across 6sts, k6  
Row 15 - k6, (p3, ssk, k2, p3, k1, yo, k2) repeat (to) across to last 9sts, p3, k6  
Row 16 - k9, (p4, k3, p3, k3) repeat (to) across 6sts, k6  
Row 17 - k6, (p3, ssk, k1, p3, k1, yo, k3) repeat (to) across to last 9sts, p3, k6  
Row 18 - k9, (p5, k3, p2, k3) repeat (to) across 6sts, k6  
Row 19 - k6, (p3, ssk, p3, k1, yo, k4) repeat (to) across to last 9sts, p3, k6  
Row 20 - k9, (p6, k3, p1, k3) repeat (to) across 6sts, k6

Repeat rows 1-20 until your work measures appx 27in/67.5cm ending after completing a wrong side row.

Work in garter stitch (knitting every row) for 12 more rows. Bind off. Weave in ends. Block as desired.

## Crib

Cast on 197sts. I used the long tail cast on.

Work in garter stitch (knit every row) for 12 rows.

Row 1 (rs) - k6, (p3, yo, k1, p3, k4, k2tog) repeat (to) across to last 9sts, p3, k6

Row 2 (ws) - k9, (p5, k3, p2, k3) repeat (to) across to last 6sts, k6

Row 3 - k6, (p3, k1, yo, k1, p3, k3, k2tog) repeat (to) across to last 9sts, p3, k6

Row 4 - k9, (p4, k3, p3, k3) repeat (to) across 6sts, k6

Row 5 - k6, (p3, k2, yo, k1, p3, k2, k2tog) repeat (to) across to last 9sts, p3, k6

Row 6 - k9, (p3, k3, p4, k3) repeat (to) across 6sts, k6

Row 7 - k6, (p3, k3, yo, k1, p3, k1, k2tog) repeat (to) across to last 9sts, p3, k6

Row 8 - k9, (p2, k3, p5, k3) repeat (to) across 6sts, k6

Row 9 - k6, (p3, k4, yo, k1, p3, k2tog) repeat (to) across to last 9sts, p3, k6

Row 10 - k9, (p1, k3, p6, k3) repeat (to) across 6sts, k6

Row 11 - k6, (p3, ssk, k4, p3, k1, yo) repeat (to) across to last 9sts, p3, k6

Row 12 - k9, (p2, k3, p5, k3) repeat (to) across 6sts, k6

Row 13 - k6, (p3, ssk, k3, p3, k1, yo, k1) repeat (to) across to last 9sts, p3, k6

Row 14 - k9, (p3, k3, p4, k3) repeat (to) across 6sts, k6

Row 15 - k6, (p3, ssk, k2, p3, k1, yo, k2) repeat (to) across to last 9sts, p3, k6

Row 16 - k9, (p4, k3, p3, k3) repeat (to) across 6sts, k6

Row 17 - k6, (p3, ssk, k1, p3, k1, yo, k3) repeat (to) across to last 9sts, p3, k6

Row 18 - k9, (p5, k3, p2, k3) repeat (to) across 6sts, k6

Row 19 - k6, (p3, ssk, p3, k1, yo, k4) repeat (to) across to last 9sts, p3, k6

Row 20 - k9, (p6, k3, p1, k3) repeat (to) across 6sts, k6

Repeat rows 1-20 until your work measures appx 35in/87.5cm ending after completing a wrong side row.

Work in garter stitch (knitting every row) for 12 more rows. Bind off. Weave in ends. Block as desired.

## Toddler

Cast on 249sts. I used the long tail cast on.

Work in garter stitch (knit every row) for 12 rows.

Row 1 (rs) - k6, (p3, yo, k1, p3, k4, k2tog) repeat (to) across to last 9sts, p3, k6

Row 2 (ws) - k9, (p5, k3, p2, k3) repeat (to) across to last 6sts, k6

Row 3 - k6, (p3, k1, yo, k1, p3, k3, k2tog) repeat (to) across to last 9sts, p3, k6

Row 4 - k9, (p4, k3, p3, k3) repeat (to) across 6sts, k6

Row 5 - k6, (p3, k2, yo, k1, p3, k2, k2tog) repeat (to) across to last 9sts, p3, k6

Row 6 - k9, (p3, k3, p4, k3) repeat (to) across 6sts, k6

Row 7 - k6, (p3, k3, yo, k1, p3, k1, k2tog) repeat (to) across to last 9sts, p3, k6

Row 8 - k9, (p2, k3, p5, k3) repeat (to) across 6sts, k6

Row 9 - k6, (p3, k4, yo, k1, p3, k2tog) repeat (to) across to last 9sts, p3, k6

Row 10 - k9, (p1, k3, p6, k3) repeat (to) across 6sts, k6

Row 11 - k6, (p3, ssk, k4, p3, k1, yo) repeat (to) across to last 9sts, p3, k6

Row 12 - k9, (p2, k3, p5, k3) repeat (to) across 6sts, k6

Row 13 - k6, (p3, ssk, k3, p3, k1, yo, k1) repeat (to) across to last 9sts, p3, k6

Row 14 - k9, (p3, k3, p4, k3) repeat (to) across 6sts, k6

Row 15 - k6, (p3, ssk, k2, p3, k1, yo, k2) repeat (to) across to last 9sts, p3, k6

Row 16 - k9, (p4, k3, p3, k3) repeat (to) across 6sts, k6

Row 17 - k6, (p3, ssk, k1, p3, k1, yo, k3) repeat (to) across to last 9sts, p3, k6

Row 18 - k9, (p5, k3, p2, k3) repeat (to) across 6sts, k6

Row 19 - k6, (p3, ssk, p3, k1, yo, k4) repeat (to) across to last 9sts, p3, k6

Row 20 - k9, (p6, k3, p1, k3) repeat (to) across 6sts, k6

Repeat rows 1-20 until your work measures appx 47in/117.5cm ending after completing a wrong side row.

Work in garter stitch (knitting every row) for 12 more rows. Bind off. Weave in ends. Block as desired.



## ABBREVIATIONS

**k** - knit

**P** - purl

**sl** - slip stitch

**yo** - yarn over

**k2tog** -knit 2 stitches together

**ssk** - slip next st knitwise, slip next st knitwise, place stitches back onto left needle, knit both slipped sts together
